



## Netting Installation Guide

1.	<p>Install corner fixings in every corner, or at 10m intervals along a straight stretch.</p> <p>Fixings for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Masonry - Corner Eye Bolts</li> <li>• Steelwork - Beam Bolts</li> <li>• Cladding – Cladding Bolts</li> <li>• Timber – Vine Eyes</li> </ul>	
2.	<p>In between the corner fixings install intermediate fixings at 1m intervals for 75mm and 50mm netting, or 0.5m intervals for 28mm or 19mm netting.</p> <p>Fixings for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Masonry – Screw Eyes &amp; Red Wall Plugs</li> <li>• Steelwork – Beam Clips</li> <li>• Cladding – Angle Brackets, Self Drill Screws &amp; Rubber bonded washers</li> <li>• Timber – Screw Eyes</li> </ul>	
3.	<p>Thread the wire through the corner fixing and attach using 2 wire rope grips or 2 copper ferrules. Thread the loose end of the wire through the intermediates until you have either i) reached 10m or ii) gone around 1 corner. Do not use one piece of rope around more than one corner or the system will become unstable. Please note – Cross Wires may be required for larger installations.</p>	
4.	<p>Hook an open barrel strainer to the corner fixing at the end of this stretch, pull the wire rope tight and attach it to the end of the barrel strainer, using the wire rope grips or copper ferrules as above. Close the barrel strainer until the wire is tight. Repeat this until the whole area has a wire rope framework.</p>	
5.	<p>Stretch the netting out using the 4 corner tags, then taking one corner attach the netting to the wire rope using the hog ring staples and stapler.</p> <p>One staple per mesh.</p> <p>Use netting corner ties to ensure that the tension on the net does not pull it away from the corners, by looping it through the corner fixing and the mesh of the netting.</p>

It is important to recognise that this guide is aimed to provide a guidance on the basic principals behind net installation. All netting installations are different, and whilst the theory should be applied to any application, in practice this may turn out to be very different.
